




VOCATIONS TO THE PRIESTHOOD, AND PERMANENT DIACONATE

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

Letters have been issued to parents and carers of children in Primary 4 as we are about to begin our preparations for the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Confirmation and First Communion


If your child is in Primary 4, the school, in co-operation with the parish, is about to begin preparation for the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Confirmation and First Communion.

If your child has been baptised and you wish your child to be prepared for the Sacramental Celebrations, you should complete the form enclosed with the letter sent by the school. The form must be returned, fully completed with the exact date and place of Baptism, to the school by **Friday 5th September**

If you complete the form I would like to meet with you to discuss how we will work together to prepare the children for these very important moments in their young lives.

I would wish you to attend the first meeting on **Tuesday 9th September in the school at 3.30 p.m.**, when I will outline the preparations which will involve home, school and parish.

It is an essential requirement of the Church that children should now be attending at Mass in the parish if they are to take part in these celebrations. If it is possible, the children should attend the 11 o'clock Mass on Sunday and take part in the Children's Liturgy of the Word. If that is not possible for any reason the other Masses are on Saturday at 6.00 p.m., and Sunday at 9.30 a.m.



If your child does not attend St Peter and St Paul's Primary School but you attend Mass in the parish, please speak to Fr Ken or Deacon Charles as soon as possible

Children who are Catholic and have not yet been baptised and are in Primary 4 will be considered for the Sacraments when in Primary 5 after they have been baptised.
