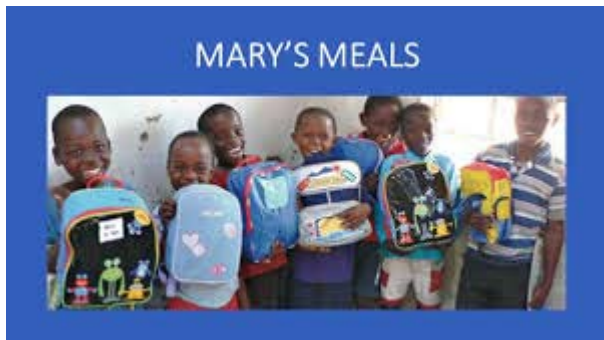


MARY'S MEALS BACKPACK APPEAL
