ECCLESIASTICAL STUDENTS FUND

The **SECOND COLLECTION** for the above fund will be taken up at all Masses today
As you may be aware we have one postgraduate student [Fr Andrew] studying in Rome and 2 students in St Mary's College, Oscott, one seminarian in Rome and two further aspirants to the Propaedeutic Year. Last year's collection for the whole Diocese raised only £9600, which represents the formations costs to cover only one third of one student per year. The total cost for a seminarian each year is approximately £28,000, consisting of seminary and university fees [£23,000], with book fees and transport costs of £4000. This year the amount required by the Diocese will be around £130,000.

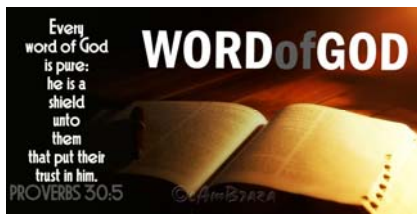
Relatives must make direct contact, either by texting or telephoning the dedicated mobile number, giving details of patient and ward number. This applies even

Diocesan Day for Lectors

to be held at St John's High School, Harefield Road, Dundee on Saturday 22 September, from 10.15 a.m.



This event is aimed at helping those who are ministers of the Word in our parishes to grow in confidence and in knowledge of the texts as they proclaim the biblical Word. The input will include reflections on the dynamism of the Word of God, understanding the Lectionary, and the Ministry of the Reader in the Liturgy. There will also be practical suggestions on the art of public speaking.

After Morning prayer there will be two addresses on **THE WORD OF GOD and THE MINISTRY OF READER**. After a packed lunch there will be a further presentation on **ADDRESSING THE ASSEMBLY - PRACTICAL HINTS FOR PUBLIC SPEAKING** and will

end with a **LITURGY OF THE WORD and BENEDICTION**, closing by 3.00 p.m.
