## CHILDREN'S SACRAMENTS

"And people were bringing children to him that he might touch them, but the disciples rebuked them. When Jesus saw this he became indignant and said to them, 'Let the children come to me; do not prevent them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these. Amen, I say to you, whoever does not accept the kingdom of God like a child will not enter it.' Then he embraced them and blessed them, placing his hands on them" (Mark 10:13-16). When Pope St. Pius X lowered the age for First Holy Communion from twelve to the age of discretion (around seven) in 1910 he expressed his hope that children who have received First Holy Communion would be regularly PARTICIPATING IN THEIR PARISHES.

We need to be mindful of the needs of our children. Not only are they the future of our Church, they are her present. Children celebrating their first sacraments is an opportunity for parents to look at their lives and see what they want for themselves and their children.

If you are not going to be a practicing Catholic family there does not seem much point to force your kids through all the preparation involved for the sacraments. It would appear a contradiction in your lives. Saying one thing but doing the opposite. The sacraments are for those who have faith in Jesus and live that faith with others in the community. We go to mass not because we are obliged but to celebrate the resurrection of Jesus, his presence among us giving us strength to continue the mass in our daily lives. As part of their preparation for the sacraments the children must be participating at mass.

The parish and school community want to make it very clear; if your child is a candidate for any of the sacraments in 2026 they must be participating regularly at Mass now and not watching on line. A meeting of parents will be notified shortly.
